DESIRED RESULTS	INDICATORS	⑨ DATA SOURCES AND METHODS Where the data needed to track the indicators and performance measures will come from.
MOTIVATING CONDITIONS AND CAUSES		⑦ EVALUATION QUESTIONS Questions, based on indicator data and movement that will determine whether the strategy needs to be modified. Questions, based on the performance measures, that determine whether the project is working as intended, what lessons have been learned, and how the project may need to be modified in order to get better results.
STRATEGIES	PERFORMANCE MEASURES	⑧ STAKEHOLDERS The funders, collaborators, and other individuals or organizations with a vested interest in the program who need to be involved in learning from the data being collected.
ACTIVITIES		⑩ MECHANISMS FOR LEARNING The opportunities for stakeholders to come together and learn from and make decisions based on the data about the program.
